Code of Conduct-Student/Parent Agreement & Registration Form (Summer school / Fast Forward)

South Haven High School is pleased to offer a new type of learning experience for current high school students who need to make up academic credit or incoming high school students who would like to prepare for the year ahead. Participation in this program is a privilege and is subject to special rules and behavioral expectations. This agreement is intended to assure that students and parents/guardians understand these expectations.

1. The instructor is the teacher of record and is responsible for developing and maintaining a positive learning environment. He or she has the authority and will make decisions regarding grades, coursework, and any disciplinary issues that arise.
2. Students are responsible for their behavior and language from the time they arrive until the time they leave the school. Students will choose to behave and speak in the same manner in which they are expected during the school year.
3. Students may not leave the classroom without the instructor's permission. Students who do so may be terminated from the program.
4. Smoking/use of drugs or alcoholic beverages is not allowed on the grounds of the school. Students who violate this rule will be immediately terminated from the program.
5. Students may only use headphones or cellular phones with permission during class. Students using these devices without permission will be given one warning. Second violation may result in termination from the class.
6. Appropriate school dress is required. Student dress judged inappropriate by the instructor will receive a warning. Second offenses will result in the student being asked to leave and will result in an absence.
7. Sleeping during class or being asked to leave a class because of behavior is viewed as an absence.
8. Students must remain in the building during the breaks and scheduled class times.
9. Students can only be absent three (3) times. Students with more than three (3) absences will not earn credit.
10. Three (3) tardies will equal one absence.
